### Summer Holidays:



This summer we had a summer camp in the country. The children enjoyed the fresh air. An English team of 5 persons came over to assist our team workers and together we had a lot of fun doing all kinds of sports, playing games, swimming in the nearby river, doing bible studies and making a camp



fire. It was lovely to see how all our children were functioning as one big family.


### School:



Uncouraged all our children went back to school in September. After a 3 months' holiday they were really keen to go. Books, notebooks, pens and pencils, school uniforms etc. had been purchased in advance. Almost all of our children are doing well in school. One of them, Munchtsetseg, even received a medal for being first in her class.

Dorjoo will stay in kindergarten for another year because he is a little behind. This year he will receive remedial teaching so that next year he will be able to go to primary school.

Some of our older kids have entered a vocational training. They are learning how to become a cook and a beautician and one boy is learning how to make carpets. Some of our girls have gone to university.



### Haschaa:



Our haschaa house is ready and we have celebrated an official opening. Also our foster home children were invited. The girls enjoy their new accommodation.

As we stated in our last newsletter we would like to build a shower and a toilet next to our haschaa house. However, because we don't have running water on our haschaa this turns out to be a rather expensive project. This costs will be about 10.000 euros.

One of our haschaa girls has problems bowing her knees and she has also back problems. The toilet (a hole in the ground) we now use is a problem for her.

So far we have received some gifts for this project and we hope that many more will follow.
