Today we went to a ger district in an icy snowstorm where we visited a family because they had a newly born baby. Snow and ice everywhere together with hills and an unpaved road full of holes. We could hardly reach the top of some hills with our van because it was so icy. But it was worth all our efforts when we saw the cute little baby. I could give them a blanket knit by an elderly woman in Holland. The storm blew around the ger and the blanket was put into use immediately because inside it was also cold.

Our new haschaa house



We received money from the Dutch Embassy in Beijing to build a house for our homeless new teenage girls. However, the money was not enough because all the building materials had become much more expensive. At that time in Holland, a group of enthusiastic people started organizing a big party for which they charged an entrance fee. Many things were put up for auction and it turned out that the proceeds were gigantic.



Therefore we could commence with building our house right away. Isn't that great? The house is almost finished now and together with our children, we will organize an opening party.



The new house consists of three units. One unit has its own entrance. This unit is for a couple of girls who live with their grandfather and whom we have sponsored for years. The girls are at university. The other two units are for girls who are special needs pupils. They will receive vocational training. Two sisters turned out to have another five-year-old sister who had no place to live. So we decided to welcome her in our house.

Our other girls' house now is for the girls who are mentally retarded and who have little jobs. It is wise that they stay and live with us because we can offer them protection and that is what they need.

The foster homes

The children had a two weeks holiday and we all made a trip into the countryside. We were all in need of some fresh air! Although it was really cold, the children hardly noticed. They played football and all kinds of other games. Seeing all these happy children singing during the bus ride and playing together as if they are one big family always makes me happy. They are looking forward to celebrating Christmas together. It is a highlight for them and a couple of our older boys asked me if they could help with the preparations for Christmas.



Someone from Holland sent us underwear for the children as a Christmas gift. It looks lovely. The families we support will be given a set of sheets.

Our staff

I am proud to introduce our office staff to you. Without them, I could not do this work. Together they do an enormous amount of work. Many, many rules have to be observed. Weekly and monthly all kind of questionnaires have to be filled in and taken to the inspection. Also the tax work is time consuming. Our foster homes are visited on a weekly basis in order to see whether everything functions well. These people are key figures and that is why our work can continue when I am in Holland. They will introduce themselves:

Jagaa:

"My name is Jagaa and I have worked for Mongolian Children Foundation for six years now. I am so thankful to work here because Gods peace, joy and grace is in this place. I would like to thank Asian Foundation and you all for the support and help for us`.

Jinzo:

"I am called Chinzorig and I work 3 days a week for Mongolian Children Foundation. Many homeless children in Mongolia have received a home and family and most important is that they have learned about the love of the Lord Jesus. I mostly work at the office and do all kind of paper work. I like getting to know the children in the foster homes. It fills me with joy to see how loved these children are and how they are treated with so much care. The help and the interest you show for these precious children is never in vain!"

Odnoo:

"Hallo my name is Odnoo. I work with the children, foster home mothers and with the families, we support. I am always thankful that I am able to do this work. The lives of our children have changed completely. Their hope for the future has been restored and that is thanks to you! Thank you for everything!"
